**Meeting May 3, 2022**

- 1) **Meeting called to order 7:00 pm.**
- 2) **Opening prayer** was said, followed by **The Pledge of Allegiance.**

We’ll also plan to assemble with AL Post 527 at 9 a.m. at Henderson Park, making sure our post flag, American flag and POW flags all present and accounted for. We deploy with whatever supplies and with whoever shows up. As in other years, we’ll assemble at our designated cemeteries prior to Memorial Day and assure an American flag is posted at every veteran grave from Peninsula Park to Northport Pier. o post our monthly News Letters and Post monthly minutes will continue to be posted on [www.doorcountyveterans.com](http://www.doorcountyveterans.com).

- 12) **Good of the Order:** We zoomed our swearing-in ceremonies and left Zoom cameras on after the meeting to encourage members to stick around and socialize.
